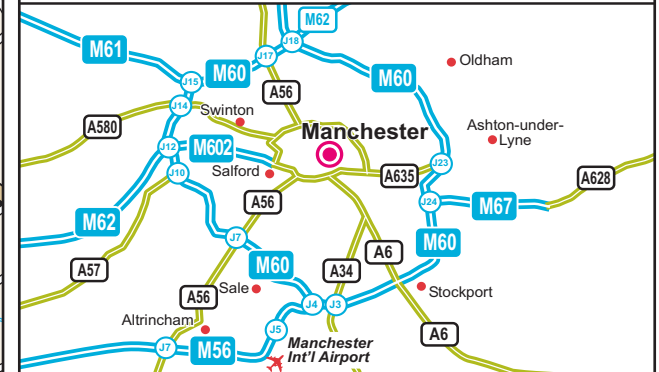

- From the M56**
- Leave the M56 at junction 3a and join the A5103 (Princess Road) towards the City Centre.
  - At the roundabout underneath the Mancunian Way, continue straight across onto Medlock Street (signposted St Peter's Square).
  - At the traffic lights, turn left into Whitworth Street and then turn right onto Deansgate (A56).
  - Spinningfields is on the left hand side, turn onto Hardman Street and you will find our office on the left hand side.
- From the M62 / Liverpool**
- Join the M62 towards Manchester.
  - At Junction 12, take the M602 towards the city centre and take the right hand lane at the end of the M602 along the A57.
  - Go under the railway bridge and take the left exit.
  - Turn left towards Manchester city centre and proceed along A56 (Deansgate).
  - Spinningfields is on the left hand side, turn onto Hardman Street and you will find our office on the left hand side.
- Parking P**
- Public car parks are located on the map.
  - Meter parking is available in some surrounding streets.
- Disabled Parking**
- There is one disabled parking bay on-site at the Manchester office. Please contact [clientsupport.manchester@dwf.law](mailto:clientsupport.manchester@dwf.law) for availability.
  - The nearest off-site disabled parking bays are located at NCP Spinningfields, M3 3BE or NCP Great Northern, M3 4EE.
- MetroLink M**
- St Peter's Square & Deansgate-Castlefield MetroLink stations are both a 15 minute walk from our offices.
  - Services run to and from Piccadilly and Victoria railway stations.
- Train**
